Former CIA Director to speak at USD

William E. Colby, former director of the Central Intelligence Agency, will appear in a public address at the University of San Diego, November 9 at 8 p.m., discussing "the turbulent world around us and the ways in which America must mobilize to defend itself."

His talk is sponsored by the USD Associated Student Body. Tickets will be sold at the door; admission is \$3.

Colby has spent his life in intelligence, from his earliest days parachuting to French and Norwegian resistance forces behind German lines in World War II, to his service as CIA director from 1973 to 1976. During the intervening years, he served in Stockholm, Rome, and Saigon and as Chief of the Far East Division. He returned to Vietnam in 1968 to direct American support of the pacification program of the Government of South Vietnam with the personal rank of ambassador. In 1972 he was named executive director and comptroller of the CIA, and in 1973 became the agency's director.

Currently an attorney in the Washington office of Reid and Priest, specializing in international legal matters, Colby is the author of numerous articles and has published a book, Honorable Men: My Life in the CIA.
