NEWSPAPER WORKSHOP FOR TEACHERS

TO BE HELD AT USD

A "Newspaper Workshop" will be held at the University of San Diego on Friday, January 29 from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. and on Saturday, January 30 from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. in DeSales Hall room 209.

Tuition for the workshop, sponsored by USD's School of Education and Continuing Education, is \$50. Beverages will be provided; a sack lunch is suggested. For further information call 293-4585.

Designed to instruct teachers on the use of the daily newspaper as a learning tool, the workshop provides one unit of professional development or inservice credit. Two hours of classroom application are required to receive credit.

Elementary and secondary teachers will be instructed in the use of the newspaper to teach mathematics, reading and language arts, economics, vocational education, spelling, and other subjects. Participants will learn to use all parts of a newspaper, including the sports pages, classifieds, photos, captions, comics, and headlines in a lecture /demonstration format.
