NORTH COUNTY RESIDENT FEATURED SOLOIST

AT USD CONCERT APRIL 25

North county resident David De Valera will be one of two featured soloists at the University of San Diego's Sister Rossi Scholarship Fund Concert on Sunday, April 25 at 4:00 p.m. in USD's Camino Theater.

General admission tickets are \$3.50; students and seniors, \$1.50 and may be purchased at the door. Proceeds of the concert benefit the Sr. Rossi Scholarship Fund.

USD undergraduate audition winners, David de Valera of Vista and Paul Nagem of San Diego are the featured soloists. Pianist David De Valera will play the first movement of Beethoven's Concerto No. 3 and flutist Paul Nagem will play the first movement of Concerto for Flute and Strings by J. C. Bach.

The USD Orchestra, conducted by Dr. Henry Kolar, will perform Beethoven's Sixth Symphony, "The Pastorale," and "Andante for Strings," composed by USD Fine Arts Professor Henry Kolar.

This year's Sr. Rossi Scholarship Concert will be dedicated to the memory of USD student Ronald Cayabyab who died during the 1982 academic year. He was the featured soloist at last year's concert when he played a Shostakovich piano concerto.
