"CAUGHT IN THE MIDDLE AND NOWHERE TO GO"

TOPIC OF SEMINAR AT USD NOVEMBER 18

"Caught in the Middle and Nowhere to Go" is the topic of the November 18 seminar, part of the University of San Diego's Interfaith Seminar series "Women and Issues."

Presented by Dr. Mary Colacicco and Sr. RayMonda, "Caught in the Middle" profiles women in crisis and the complexities of economic dilemmas facing them.

Mary Colacicco, Ph.D. is Executive Director of Travelers Aid. RayMonda DuVall is C.H.S. Director, Emergency Assistance, House of Rachel, Catholic Community Services. Dr. Colacicco and Sr. RayMonda work daily with a downtown population "caught in the middle" ranging from those down on their luck to the chronic and severely disturbed.

The program includes a continental breakfast at 7:30 a.m. followed by the seminar at 8:00 a.m. Registration is \$10 for the seminar sponsored by USD's Continuing Education in cooperation with the San Diego County Ecumenical Conference and the National Conference of Christians and Jews.
