TO SPEAK AT USD JAN. 27

Bureau of Consumer Protection Director Timothy Muris will speak at the University of San Diego on Thursday, January 27, at 1:00 p.m. in the Grace Courtroom, More Hall.

"A Conservative Program for Protecting Consumers," will be presented by Muris, Consumer Protection Director since October, 1981.

The public is invited to attend the presentation coordinated by USD Distinguished Professor of Law Bernard Siegan who says, "Tim Muris approaches consumer protection in a much more realistic way than many others in the field, and he is well worth listening to."

Muris, who holds a J.D., Order of the Coif, from the University of California, Los Angeles, served as Deputy Counsel, Presidential Task Force on Regulatory Relief in 1981. From 1976 to 1981, Muris was on the faculty of the University of Miami School of Law and Law and Economics Center and was assistant to the Director, Office of Policy Planning and Evaluation, Federal Trade Commission from 1974 to 1976. He was graduated with high honors and distinction from San Diego State University.
