THIRD ANNUAL SPORTS LAW SYMPOSIUM

AT USD MARCH 19-20

The University of San Diego School of Law will present the Third Annual Sports Law Symposium on March 19 and 20 from 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. in the Grace Courtroom, More Hall.

Space is limited and pre-registration is suggested. Registration of \$70, general admission, and \$25 for students, includes the two-day symposium, refreshments, lunch, and symposium materials. Sponsored by the USD School of Law Labor-Management Relations Center and the Student Bar Association, the Sports Law Symposium features lectures and panel discussions by prominent professional and collegiate sports law authorities. Each discussion is followed by a question and answer period. The symposium is designed for attorneys, law students, paralegals, sports professionals and persons interested in sports and the law.

Symposium speakers and topics include: Sam Kagel, Kagel and Kagel and mediator for the 1982 NFL strike, speaking on his role as mediator in collective bargaining disputes; Larry Fleisher, executive director of the NBA Players Association, Russell Granik, general counsel for the NBA, Alan I. Rothenberg, Manatt, Phelps, Rothenberg and Tunney, and Paul Silas, coach of the San Diego Clippers Basketball Club, speaking on

collective bargaining and professional basketball.

President of the San Diego Sockers John Daley will speak on "The Past, Present and Future of Professional Soccer." Howard Daniels, Blecher and Collins and co-counsel with Maxwell Blecher in Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum Commission v. National Football League will discuss their antitrust suit against the NFL. David Meggyesy, assistant to the executive director of the NFL Players Association, and Leigh Steinberg, attorney and player representative, will speak on player representation.

Violence in professional sports is the topic of Chris J. Carlson, attorney in the Legal-Business Affairs Department at The Burbank Studios, and James P. Feeney, Dykema, Gossett, Spencer, Goodnow and Trigg. General counsel for the NFL Management Council Sargent Karch will address management's role in the collective bargaining process.

Loyola Law School professor of law Lionel Sobel will speak on player draft and compensation systems in professional sports.

Andy Coats, Crowe and Dunlevy, will discuss the University of Oklahoma antitrust action against the NCAA. General counsel for the NFL Jay E. Moyer will cover antitrust dilemmas in professional sports.
