The summer schedule for "Computer Resources for Educators," a series of one-day courses designed to train educators, counselors, and administrators in the use of microcomputers in the educational setting, has been scheduled at the University of San Diego.

Tuition for each course in the series sponsored by USD's School of Education and Continuing Education is \$50 with an additional \$25 for courses requiring extensive hands-on computer work. For registration call 293-4585.
