TRW CHAIRMAN TO DEDICATE MANCHESTER CENTER

Ruben F. Mettler, chairman of the board and chief executive officer of TRW Inc., will assist in the dedication of The Douglas F. Manchester Executive Conference Center on Sunday, February 26. The Conference Center will feature a lecture hall, Board of Trustee Room, seminar and class rooms and offices.

TRW is a worldwide scientific organization with technological facilities located in San Diego. Dr. Mettler was elected to the corporation's top post in December, 1977, following a distinguished career as an electric and aeronautical engineer. He is a member of President Reagan's National Productivity Advisory Committee and has served as vice chairman of the Defense Industry Advisory Council, chairman of the President's Task Force on Science Policy, and as a member of the President's Blue Ribbon Defense Panel. In addition, Dr. Mettler serves on the boards of other companies, including the BankAmerica Corporation, and is active in a number of business and public service organizations.

"We are fortunate to have Dr. Mettler on hand to symbolize the promise of the Center," USD President Author E. Hughes said. "The Center will become the hub of intellectual thought on campus, and Dr. Mettler's renown serves to make this dedication a truly prestigious event."

Dr. Mettler will inaugurate the Center's auditorium with a lecture at 2:00 p.m. A ribbon-cutting ceremony will immediately follow the lecture.
