CHINA STUDY AND CULTURAL TOUR SCHEDULED JUNE 17-JULY 2

Dr. Philip O. Hwang, Professor of Education and Director of Division in Counseling and Human Services at University of San Diego will lead a China study and cultural tour from June 17-July 2. Dr. Hwang, a native of China, is taking his fifth tour.

The tour will visit Beijing, "the city of northern peace", Xian, home of the famous terracotta warriors, Shanghai, city of eleven million inhabitants, Hangzhou, known for the scenic beauty of the West Lake, Guilin, where poets and artists go for meditation and inspiration, and Canton, center for China's foreign trades. During the tour, participants will have ample opportunity to visit schools and educational centers and confer with Chinese experts on educational matters. Dr. Hwang will also conduct seminars and discussion groups during the tour.
