### WORKSHOPS ON HUMAN SEXUALITY AND SEX THERAPY

### SCHEDULED AT USD, MARCH AND APRIL

"Workshops on Human Sexuality and Sex Therapy," designed for teachers, counselors, nurses and physicians, will be held in March and April at the University of San Diego. Registration is \$120 per workshop or \$200 for both workshops. Limited partial scholarships are available; call Dr. Phillip O. Hwang, 293-4539 for details. Sessions will be held in The Douglas F. Manchester Executive Conference Center on the campus. For brochure and registration, call USD's School of Continuing Education, 293-4585.

Workshop 1 "Human Sexuality" will be held on Friday, March 30 from 5:00 to 10:00 p.m. and on Saturday, March 31 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Workshop 2 "Sex Therapy" is set for Friday, April 27 from 5:00 to 10:00 p.m. and Saturday, April 28, 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Each workshop has been approved by the USD School of Education for one semester unit of extension credit. Physicians attending these workshops may report one hour per workshop of Category 1 credit toward the California Medical Association Certificate in Continuing Medical Education.

Theresa L. Crenshaw, M.D., workshop director, will present the biology of human sexuality and an overview of normal human sexual response from a medical doctor's point of view. Psychological, physical and medical causes of sexual problems will be discussed, as will the cures. Participants will be trained in specific therapeutic techniques for treating sexual dysfunctions and ethical principles will be presented.

Currently, the Director of the Crenshaw Clinic in San Diego and Co-Chair of Human Sexuality, Department of Reproductive Medicine at the University of California, San Diego, Medical School, Crenshaw is a graduate of Stanford University and the University of California, Irvine, Medical School and was a fellow of the Masters and Johnson Institute in St. Louis. Crenshaw has appeared on the Phil Donahue and Merv Griffin television shows, Home Box Office, and Educational Cable Television. Most recently, she is the author of "Bedside Manners, Your Guide to Better Sex."
