BEHAVIORAL, LEARNING DISORDERS FOCUS OF USD SYMPOSIUM

Eleven workshops, two pre-symposium workshops, and a keynote address by Samuel A. Kirk, Ph.D., professor of special education at the University of Arizona, will focus on "Returning to Excellence: Quality Instruction for the Learning Disabled and Behavorially Disordered Child" at the Ninth Annual Symposium on Behavorial and Learning Disorders sponsored by the Division of Special Education, University of San Diego School of Education, on April 13 and 14.

The symposium will highlight professionals from all areas of the Southwest, lecturing and leading discussions on strategies for dealing with children who may have behavioral and/or learning disorders.

Registration fees are \$35 for each of the two days, \$15 per day for full-time students, and an additional \$25 per day will cover one unit of graduate continuing education credit. Persons attending for professional credit will also be required to prepare a research paper. Registration fee for Friday includes dinner; Saturday's fee includes a continental breakfast and luncheon.

Pre-registration for the event, which will be held in The Douglas F. Manchester Executive Conference Center on the USD campus off Linda Vista Road, is requested by April 8 to insure attendance. Participants may also register at the door.
