2 DAUGHTERS OF LA JOLLAN  
XAVIER WIECHERS GRADUATE

Cecilia Wiechers and her sister, Lucia Wiechers Mijares, both of La Jolla, graduated Sunday, May 26, from the University of San Diego.

They are two of five daughters of Xavier and Josefina Wiechers, who moved to La Jolla 12 years ago from Mexico City. Xavier Wiechers is an architect who owns his own construction company in Tijuana.

The Wiechers family, for the past four years, have been transporting food and blankets, donated by themselves and fellow La Jollans, to the Casa de los Povres, a home for the poor in Tijuana. Sometimes the family donates food and blankets to the downtown Tijuana jail.

Cecilia, 23, graduated with a master's degree in education. She is teaching third grade at All Hallows Academy in La Jolla.

Lucia, 22, graduated with a bachelor's in French and plans to attend USD in the fall to begin work on a master's in special education for the handicapped.

Both women graduated with honors, each receiving  
"oustanding student" awards from their respective schools.
