FORMER CIA AGENT TO SPEAK ON "SECRET WARS OF THE CIA"

John Stockwell, a former Central Intelligence Agency agent, is scheduled to speak on "The Secret Wars of the CIA: From Vietnam to Nicaragua," at 8 p.m. Tuesday, Oct. 22, in Salomon Lecture Hall at the University of San Diego.

Stockwell, with the CIA for 13 years, bills himself as the highest ranking CIA official to openly criticize the spy agency.

He says he was an advisor to the National Security Council, CIA station chief in Angola and officer-in-charge of Tay Ninh Province, Vietnam.

He is the author of "In Search of Enemies," a book that analyzes the CIA covert action in the Angola civil war, and a book that resulted in a lawsuit brought against him by the federal government.

The USD program, scheduled for two hours, includes a question-answer session. Salomon Lecture Hall is located inside DeSales Hall.

The program, sponsored by the student body, is free and open to the public.
