STUDENTS VOLUNTEER TO HELP SENIOR CITIZENS AT HOME

For the eighth straight year, University of San Diego students will give up a weekend to help area senior citizens with their household chores on Saturday and Sunday Nov. 16-17.

Two to four students will go into each of the 15 to 30 homes selected throughout the county, according to Debbie Dyar, student coordinator of Senior Citizen Outreach Weekend.

"Many seniors are disabled and have trouble getting things done around the house, so we are going to help them," said Dyar.

Students, who can sign up for one or two days of work, will mow lawns, wash windows, paint fences and other chores.
