JOURNEY TO HALLEY'S COMET DEC. 3 WITH DR. KAUFMANN

"Comets, Mr. Halley and the Dinosaurs" is the title of William J. Kaufmann's lecture set from 7:30-9:30 p.m.
Tuesday, Dec. 3, at the University of San Diego.

Kaufmann, a nationally recognized astrophysicist, will describe what can be seen in 1986 with the comet's visit. He will also show a computer generated film depicting the flights of five spacecraft which are now on their way to Halley's Comet.

Kaufmann was a visiting scholar asssigned to the Jet Propulsion Laboratory in Pasadena and has been on the faculties of UCLA, California Institute of Technology and San Diego State University.

He is perhaps best known for his book, "Black Holes and Warped Spacetime," for which he received the 1980 American Institute of Physics-U.S. Steel Science Writing Award.

The two-hour lecture will take place in the Manchester Executive Conference Center. A wine and cheese reception will follow. Admission is \$10.
