THREE COMMENCEMENTS SET FOR MAY 23, 24 --  
ERNEST HAHN AMONG HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENTS

An estimated 1,250 students will graduate this weekend during three separate commencement exercises at the University of San Diego's football stadium.

The School of Law, which will graduate 260 students, has scheduled its ceremonies for 10:30 a.m. Saturday, May 23.

At 10:30 a.m. Sunday, May 24, the graduate schools of Business, Education, Nursing and Arts & Sciences will hold a joint commencement ceremony with an estimated 250 students receiving degrees.

At 2:30 p.m. Sunday, some 740 undergraduates will receive bachelor's degrees.

Shopping center developer Ernest Hahn will receive an honorary degree at the undergraduate ceremony. He is expected to make remarks. Hahn is vice chairman of the USD Board of Trustees.

At the law school graduation, honorary doctorate of law degree recipient Boris Bittker, a Yale Law School professor emeritus, will address the students.

Dr. Alexander George, Graham H. Stuart Professor of International Relations and Political Sciences at Stanford
