USD STUDENT APPOINTED TO CALIFORNIA STUDENT AID COMMISSION

One of four students on the twenty member committee

On October 23, Laura Adame will be in Sacramento representing thousands of students attending private universities. That's the date of her first meeting as a member of the Program, Policy and Operations Committee for the California Student Aid Commission (CSAC).

The committee advises the CSAC, which administers the CAL Grant Programs, the student loan programs and all other student financial programs in the state of California. As the newest member of the committee, she will be one of four students, each representing a different branch of our educational system. The remainder of the twenty-member committee is comprised of financial aid directors, banking vice-presidents, high school counselors and system-wide administrators.

Laura Adame is presently a junior at the University of San Diego majoring in accounting. She has been on the Deans list four semesters with Honors. She received the American Institute of Certified Accountants Scholarship, a Cal Grant and various other scholarship awards.

Laura has gained additional experience by working in the USD Financial Aid Office since 1987. She has also been a mentor for new students through the USD Mentor Program.
