MARTIN LUTHER KING MURAL REPLICA GOES ON DISPLAY AT USD

"A Tribute to Martin Luther King, Jr.: The Making of a Mural" goes on display in the Hahn University Center at the University of San Diego starting Monday, February 11 and running through Friday, February 15.

The traveling exhibit, measuring 12 feet by 7 feet, features a replica of the original 56-foot King Mural now on permanent display at the Martin Luther King Memorial Library in Washington, D.C. The King Mural, painted by artist Don Miller, chronicles the life of Dr. King, starting with his Atlanta birthplace and a family portrait from his childhood, through his leadership of the American civil rights movement, and ending with his untimely death in Memphis in 1968.

Don Miller will give a special presentation on "A Tribute to Martin Luther King, Jr.: The Making of a Mural" on Wednesday, February 13, at 7 p.m. in Forum AB in the Hahn University Center. The presentation is free and open to the public.
