**USD NAMES IN THE NEWS  
FALL 1992**

**SISTER SALLY FURAY**, USD Vice-President and Provost, has been elected the President of the Board of Directors of the San Diego Community Foundation, a non-profit organization that builds and preserves charitable assets for San Diego County, and meets community needs through financial awards and organizational support.

**DR. L. COLETTE JONES** has been named Associate Dean and Professor at USD's Philip Y. Hahn School of Nursing. Prior to her appointment, she served as Professor and Associate Dean, Graduate Nursing Program, at the University of Nebraska. She is a fellow of the American Academy of Nursing.

**DR. ORLANDO ESPÍN**, a USD Associate Professor of Theological and Religious Studies, has become president of the Academy of Catholic Hispanic Theologians of the United States. Espín has also become the first Hispanic ever to be elected as a member of the board of directors of the Catholic Theological Society of America. He is also editor-in-chief of the Journal of Hispanic/Latino Theology.

**SCOTT KUNKEL**, Assistant Professor of Management, has received the Heizer Award for Outstanding Research in the field of New Enterprise Development. The Heizer Award is bestowed by the Entrepreneurship Division of the Academy of Management to honor the world's top doctoral dissertations. Kunkel's dissertation, "The Importance of Strategy and Industry Structure on New Venture Performance," will be published in book form.

**ELIZABETH A. COBBS**, USD Associate Professor of History, has written a book entitled, The Rich Neighbor Policy: Rockefeller and Kaiser in Brazil, published by Yale University Press. The book has been awarded the Allan Nevins Prize by the Society of American Historians.

**MARIA MARTINEZ-COSIO**, USD Assistant Director of Public Relations, has been named chair of the board for Social Advocates for Youth (SAY) San Diego, Inc. SAY is a non-profit organization dedicated to providing psychological, educational, vocational, gang-prevention and childcare services for young people and their families.

**JOSE CARDENAS**, lead cook for USD's Main Dining Room, has been named Foodservice Employee of the Year (Back-of-the-House Category) by the California Restaurant Association. The award, given for the first time last year, recognizes the outstanding contributions made by California's hourly restaurant workers.
