USD LAW PROFESSOR TO SPEAK ON LAND USE

Bernard Siegan, Distinguished Professor of Law at the University of San Diego, will speak April 22 on "Regulating the Use of Land." Siegan's lecture is at 8 pm in Salomon Lecture Hall, De Sales Hall, and is open to the public free of charge.

Siegan, in addition to teaching at USD, writes a weekly column published in 23 newspapers in cities across the country.

Siegan obtained his J.D. degree from the University of Chicago Law School. He is the author of Land Use Without Zoning (1972) and Other People's Property (1976). His articles on zoning, land use and urban planning have appeared in professional journals, newspapers and magazines.
