FOUR SOUTH BAY RESIDENTS NAMED TO STUDENT "WHO'S WHO"

Mary Costello and Donald Slater of Chula Vista, Michael Sandez of National City, and Carmelina Rodriguez of San Ysidro have all been named in the 1979-80 edition of "Who's Who Among Students in American Universities and Colleges."

Costello, Slater and Sandez, all seniors at the University of San Diego, and Rodriguez, a junior at USD, join 45 other USD students named in the directory.

The directory, first published in 1934, consists of students from more than 1,200 higher education institutions from around the country and several foreign nations.

"We selected students who have made outstanding contributions in academic achievement, service to the community, and leadership in extracurricular activities, in addition to future potential," explained Tom Cosgrove, Associate Dean of Students at USD and chairperson of the nominating committee which made recommendations to the directory.

The committee was composed of faculty, students and administrators, and considered USD junior and senior students who had maintained a minimum 3.0 grade point average.
