"Teaching Cross-Cultural Values in a Multi-Cultured Community" is the topic of the Thursday, April 21 "UPDATE for Educators" seminar held at the University of San Diego from 4:00 to 5:30 p.m. in Camino Lounge.

Sponsored by the USD School of Education and Continuing Education, "UPDATE for Educators" is a four-part series focusing on aspects of education important to teachers, administrators, and counselors in the San Diego area. Remarking on the diverse population and variety of different cultures present in San Diego, seminar leader Pauline Garner, Ph.D. relates, "As educators we have a responsibility to help our students become aware of the other cultures among which they live and to understand and accept differences in lifestyles and cultural practices." Garner examines the importance of teaching cross-cultural values and presents techniques which can be implemented in today's classrooms.

President of Garner Associates, Dr. Garner has presented over 100 training programs to businesses, hospitals and educational institutions. Currently on the faculty at San Diego State University in the Women's Studies Department, Garner has taught graduate business and psychology courses.
